- 1. Martin Sondergeld was almost 33 when he left <u>Germany</u> in <u>1855</u>, as one of the youngest in his family. He came with his wife, they had three children in Lorain, OH where she died in childbirth. He remarried for a short time, divorced.
- 2. Martin married Barbara Hagemann who at age 28 came from <u>Germany</u> in <u>1862</u> and married Martin, who was then age 44.
- 3. Johann Louis left Germany in 1852 with his family when he was 18.
- 4. His eventual wife, Dorothea Corz, arrived a year later from Germany in 1853.
- 5. Gottfried Kinsel, at age 38, and his wife Mathilda Draeger, at age 32, and their six children came from <u>Prussia (now Poland)</u> to Ohio in <u>1872</u>.
- 6. Mathilda Draeger (see above)
- 7. Godfrey Sutter, arrived about age 10 with his family from Switzerland in 1839. He became a Lutheran minister in 1863.
- 8. Mary Reif, was about 3 years old when she came to Ohio from Germany in 1849 with her family.

Ten of the fourteen are buried in Elliston, Ohio and four are buried a few miles away in Oak Harbor, Ohio. Of the seven males, 4 were probably farmers and 1 was a minister.
